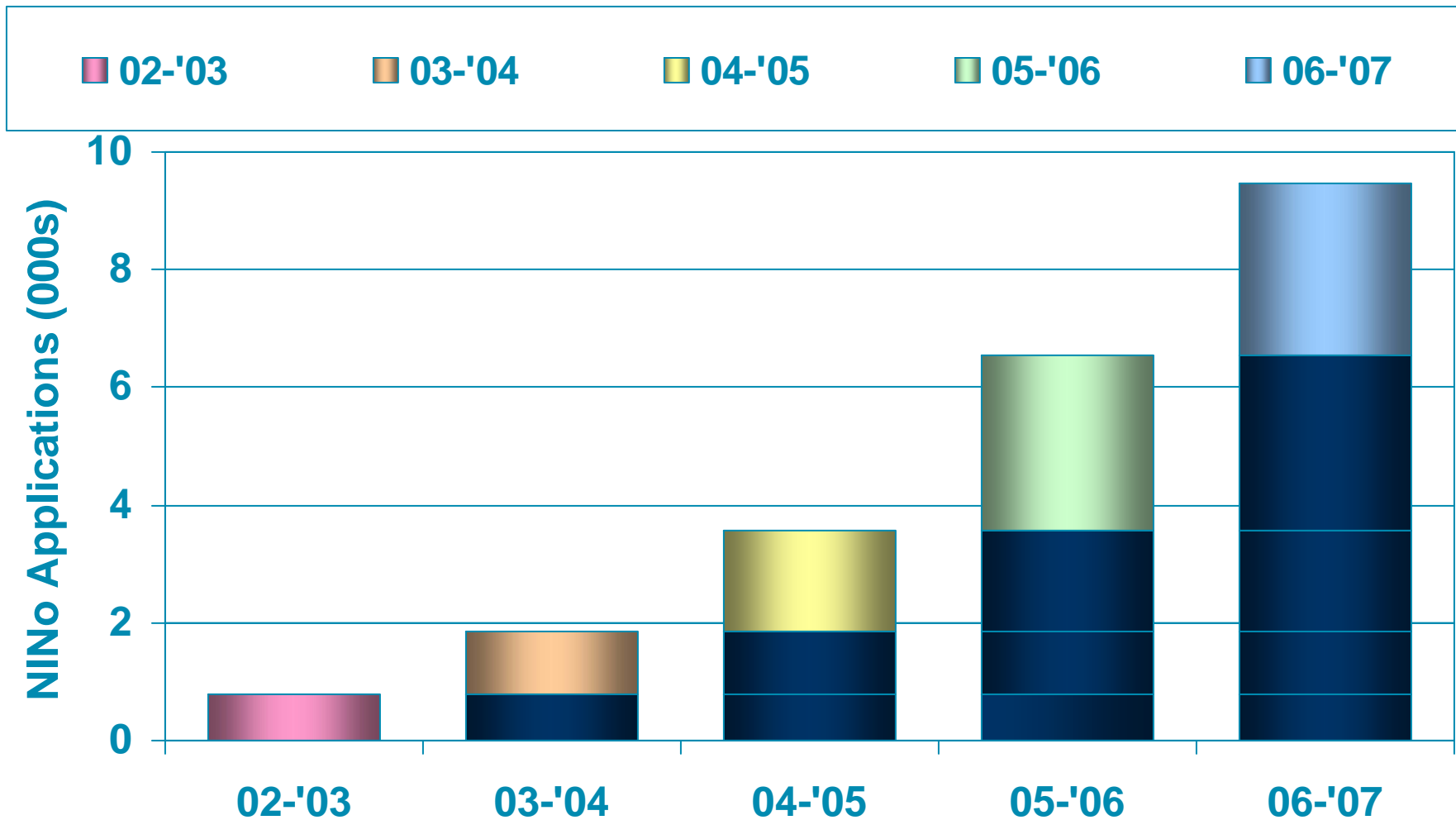
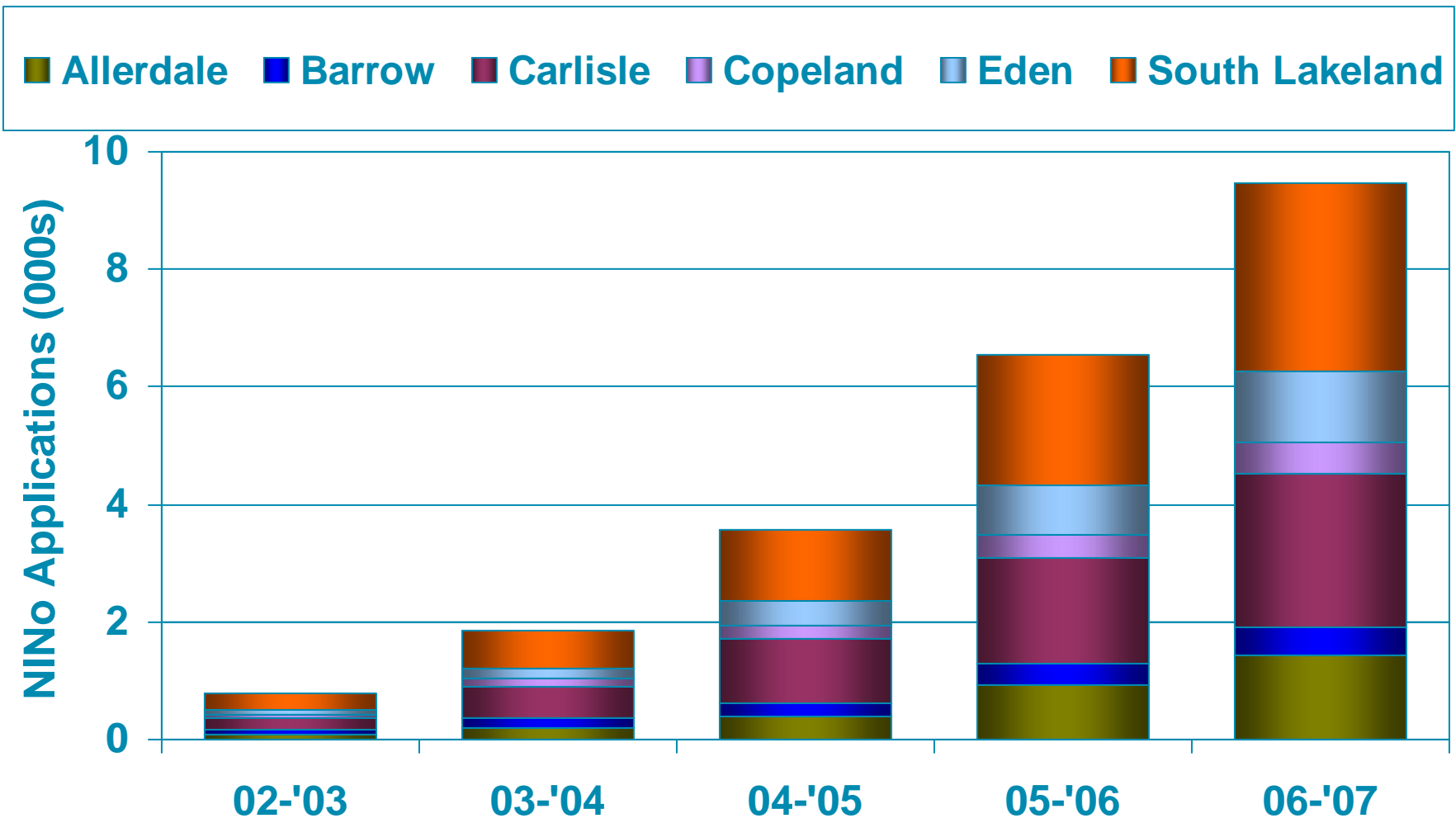


NINo Applications – growing number



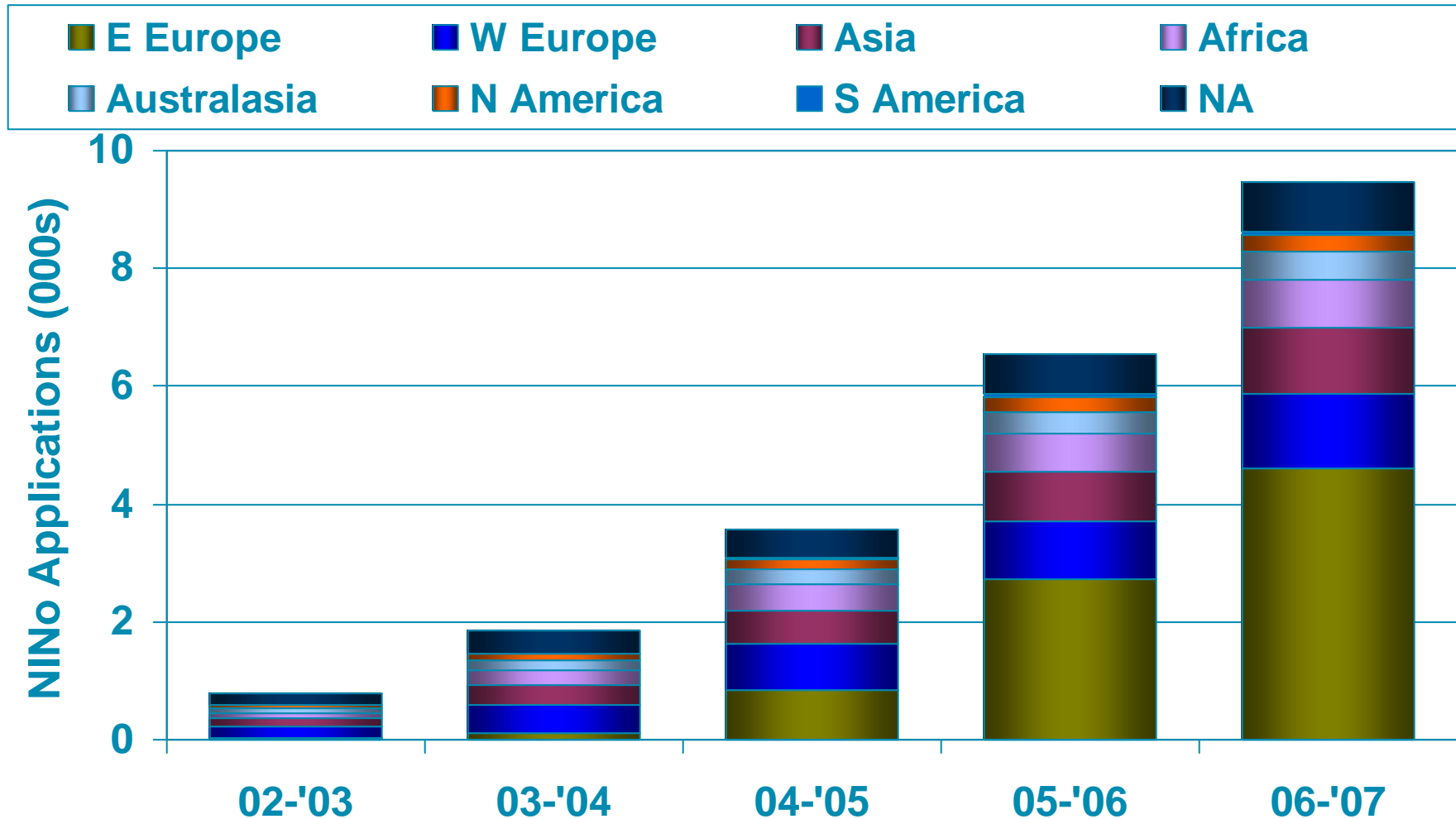
As you can see from the chart there has been a consecutive increase in the number of NINo applications since 2002-03. The most significant increase was experienced between 2005-06, a total of 2,970 applications. Between 2006-07 there was a slightly slower number of applications. Between 2003 – 2007 the county experienced an increase of almost 4 times the number of applications made in 2002 (+372%).

NINo Applications – many migrant to SLDC



The district of South Lakeland gained the highest number of migrants each year. Between 2006-07 there were 3,220 applications made for South Lakeland, making up 34% of the total applications for the county. This was followed by the district of Carlisle receiving 2,610 applications, 27% of the total applications. The district to receive the least number of applications between 2006-07 was Barrow, receiving 490 applications making up just 5.2% of the total number.

NINo Applications – many migrant to SLDC



Up until 2004, Western Europeans made up the highest number of NINo applications.

Between 2002 – 2007 the highest number of applications were received from Eastern Europeans. 8,320 applications were made making up for 37% of the total number of applications; this was followed by Western Europeans which made up 17% (3,720) of the total number of applications.

Throughout that time, and each year, the least number of applications were made by South (0.7%) and North (3.7%) America.
